Action Plan for observers

Some outstanding issues for observing the usage of clips.

- 1. We are to focus on specific tables rather than the bar as a whole. We can indicate which table we are observing usin the Wetherspoons table number embedded into each table.
- 2. We are observing *all* the people at the table being observed. For the *type of bag and current location table*, if there are multiple people being observed:

Enter the first person as 1 in the table. If they have more than one bag, then use 1a, 1b and so on. The second person would be entered as 2; for multiple bags 2a, 2b etc etc.

- 3. We need to come up with a code for each type(s) of prototype clip so that we can show which one we are observing
- 4. After observation we can approach each table and ask if they would be willing to fill out survey. [this targeted approach may not produce that many yeses tho I adopted a blanket sweep method when doing surveys and still was hard to crank up the N].

Methodological issues

How are we to select the table(s) we observe:

- 1) Randomly
- 2) Systematically [preferred] if 10 tables are to be fitted then try and do one for each

Remembering though that we need to remain inconspicuous and therefore will be at the mercy of finding a suitable and non-invasive vantage. SO, 3) do we just pitch up where available and observe what we can see from that point (an opportunist-sampling- type methodology). THIS SEEMS THE MOST FEASABLE

In this vein do we try and get equal numbers of observations for each type of clip implemented. [sensible default position, though if say 1 type of clip is soon seen not to be used very much then we won't be able to give equal observation time... but may want to home in on why not uses, and why a few people nevertheless ARE using it. General point is that this should be a responsive strategy at this developmental stage, not a fixed obs strategy, which may be more appropriate for the main eval.]
